Policy Statement:

AASL strives to present the most qualified presenters with the most current and reliable information available. Occasionally, the best choice for a presenter, or information, is vendor specific. The use of a company's representative as a presenter doesnot endorsement of that company's product.

Focus:

Primary: AASL Staff, AASL Board of Directors, Programming Volunteers

Definition:

<u>Vendor</u>: An individual whose majority of their income is derived outside of the <u>2K</u> public/private school, or academiommunity, or, is listed as a representative or consultant for a for-profit company.

Purpose:

To define guidelines for using vendaffiliated presenters or content for AASL education courses.

Procedure:

- 1. Proposals submitted by vendors to AASL for consideration will be reviewed by AASL staff with a recommendation to the programdouir(s) to either move forward to reviewer or decline.
- 2. Vendor proposals will be considered based on the following criteria:
 - a. Programming content and how the content is connected to AASL standards with a secondary focus on the product or service.
 - b. A school librarian is either the presenter or part of the presentation.
 - c. A variety of resources are offered in addition to the primary vendor's product or service.
- 3. If proposal is acepted for review policy @ will be followed for final determination.
