# **Purpose:**

To describe the duties of the Practice Committee.

#### **Procedure:**

Committee objective(s):

1. Review and report on development in educational technology, curriculum, accountability and assessment, literacy, national learning standards, and other current library and education issues.

### Committee composition:

- 1. The co-chairs (2) are appointed by the AASL President-Elect for one-year terms. Prior practice committee experience is required. Position is limited to four consecutive years. May resume committee chair position after one year off the Practice Committee.
- 2. Committee members should consist of no more than 10 members, appointed by the AASL President-Elect for two-year terms. Position is limited to two consecutive terms.

## Committee responsibilities:

- 1. Reviews and analyzes practice trends and issues for professional school librarians.
- 2. Recommends programs, policies, and strategies to enhance the practice of school librarians.
- 3. Promotes research, policy, and practice excellence by professional school librarians.
