Policy Statement:

Any group of atleast twentyfive members of AASL, who represent a special field of activity clearly distinctfrom that of any existing section, may organize a section upon recommendation of the AASL Board of Directors. (Article IX, Section 1).

Purpose:

To outline information pertaining to all AASL sections. Additional see**sipe**cific information is contained in each sectionsolicies.

Procedure:

- 1. Each section shall establish its own policies and procedures pirtly with the Bylaws of the AASL and with the approval of the AASL Board of Directors.
- 2. Membership in a section shall be open to members of the AASL who are interested in the activities of the section, upon payment of dues. (Article IX, Section 3)
- 3. Sections may be dissolved upon recommendation of the AASL Board of Directors. (Article IX, Section 3).
- 4. The membership of each section shall elect one represer [tatthe AASL Board of Directors] Each [representative] shall serve as a voting member of the Board of Directors. The [representative] shall be elected for overlapping three terms, one third being elected each year. (Article VII. Section 5)"
