- Andrea is in need of proof editors

- The chair commended Andrea for her willingness to undertake this project in order to provide additional professional development opportunities to the profession

GODORT electronic occasional publication series on Municipal Government Information-Paul Arrigo

- Interactive database
- Links to online sites
- Phase 1-end of June: Houston MSA
- Phase 2-September: Counties within Houston MSA
- Phase 3-January 2007: 10,000-25,000 population cities included
- Phase 4-June 2007: below 10,000 population cities included
- Suggestion of Wiki as mode of delivery
- Committee suggested this project more suited as a project for State and Local Documents Task Force in order to tap into the resources there. GITCO could also be partner. Publications Committee will help in any way needed.
