still being vetted. Issues of online access are still being addressed, including online access to institutional subscribers who are not ALA members. A letter is being sent to Stanford University authorizing them to provide online access for volumes 1-26, which are searchable across issues. *DttP* wants at least 100 more subscribers in order to increase revenue to cover costs. How to make this happen is a question for the Committee and *DttP* to ponder.

Occasional Papers

An occasional papers series has been under consideration for a long time. The Committee moved this idea closer to reality by drafting the framework. This series will be open access under the auspices of the Publication Committee. The Editorial Board will consist of the chair and chairelect of the Publications Committee and two GODORT members, one with editorial experience

goal is to launch this project within the next few months. Editorial Board members and contributions are to be solicited.
