Whereas, On April 22, 1970, people in the United States and twenty-two other countries celebrated Earth Day, an environmental awareness day.


Whereas, Libraries and librarians have a responsibility to collect information on the environment and to make it available to the public.

Whereas, Many librarians have active recycling, educational and other programs supportive of civic environmental groups and research efforts, and

Whereas, These efforts have not yet become a general policy of the American Library Association urging all librarians and libraries, therefore, to take further action.

Resolved, That the American Library Association encourages its members to celebrate Earth Day as a way to focus public attention on environmental issues and to take further

Resolved, That the American Library Association urges its Board of Directors to collect and provide information on the condition of the environment, air, ground, water and living organisms from all available sources.
