



RESOLUTION ON PRINCIPLES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A NATIONAL INFORMATION INFRASTRUCTURE

- WHEREAS,** A set of principles for the development of the national information infrastructure was developed by representatives of ALA and several public and information associations at a policy forum in September 1993; and
- WHEREAS,** These principles, as a working draft, have provided a basis for discussion in the library community and in the public policy arena;
- WHEREAS,** These principles have been further elaborated within the framework of ALA policy, and will be further discussed at the 1994 Annual Conference in Miami; and
- WHEREAS,** These principles will serve as a basis for further development and evolution by working groups in a rapidly changing technological and policy environment;
- RESOLVED,** That the American Library Association support the formation of the National Information Infrastructure Assembly, to be held on February 8-10, 1995, telecommunications and information policy, and will support the Assembly's work on the subject of the national information infrastructure.
