

**RESOLUTION ON PRINCIPLES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NATIONAL INFORMATION INFRASTRUCTURE**

OF

**WHEREAS**, A set of principles for the development of the National Information Infrastructure was developed by representatives of ALA and several other major information associations at a policy forum in September 1993; and

**WHEREAS**, These principles, as a working draft, have provided a framework for library community participation in the development of the NII policy initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, These principles have been developed and refined through further review and collaboration within the framework of PCAI, and will be further discussed at the 1994 Annual Conference in Miami; and

**WHEREAS**, These principles will serve as a basis for further development and evolution by other groups in a rapidly changing technological and social environment; and now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, That the American Library Association support the principles of the National Information Infrastructure as published in the PCAI, dated August 8-10, 1993, Telecommunications and Information Policy Institute, Washington, D.C., and that the American Library Association's role in the development of the NII will be forthcoming subject to its impact on library services.
