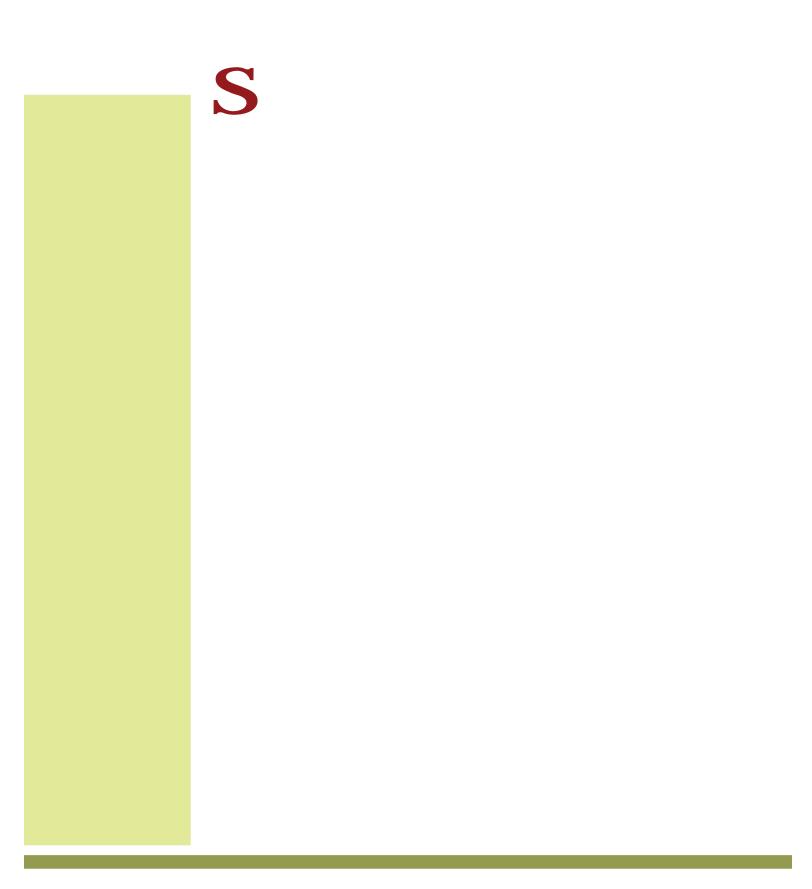

This benefits the user experience and, at the same t me, provides libraries with a greater ROI in the digital realm." (Wisniewski 57)

To summarize, QR codes o er unique opportunit es along with a fair number of challenges. Those interested in QR codes in a learning environment need to experiment with them and also monitor the research conducted by sta at the University of Bath and elsewhere. As MacKinnon and Sanford state, "As with any use of technology to provide service, a key to success for this project will be in providing purposeful and relevant access to library services through the placement of QR codes wherever and whenever it makes sense for our patrons."
