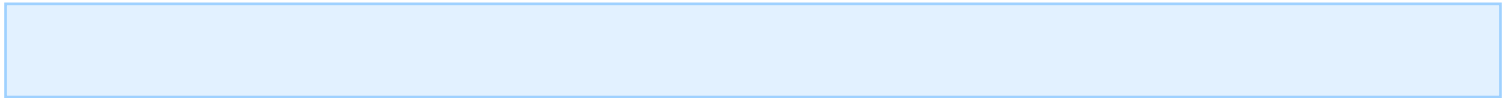
Library Instruction for Students in Online Education Programs
