#### A. Chair

- . Is required to have an active ALA Connect account for Steering communication.
- . Posts activity updates to committee and GODORT membership following the Steering Communication schedule ( , Chapter 3).
  - . Prior to Annual Conference or Midwinter Meeting: Posts agenda for committee meeting

# B. Secretary

While not an official position, it is helpful for the Committee Chair to ask for a committee member to serve as secretary for either a single meeting or the term of their appointment to the committee.

- . Secretary takes the minutes of the meeting as described in Chapter 1: Conference, Article III, Section D.
- . Secretary submits the draft minutes to the committee Chair at the end of the committee's meeting.

# C. Intern

ALA allows interns to be appointed as one-year, non-voting members of a committee. This introduces them to the workings of the committee and Round Table.

- A. According to the GODORT (Article V, Section 2), this committee will meet as necessary.
- B. It is recommended that all committee members use ALA Connect for GODORT business.
