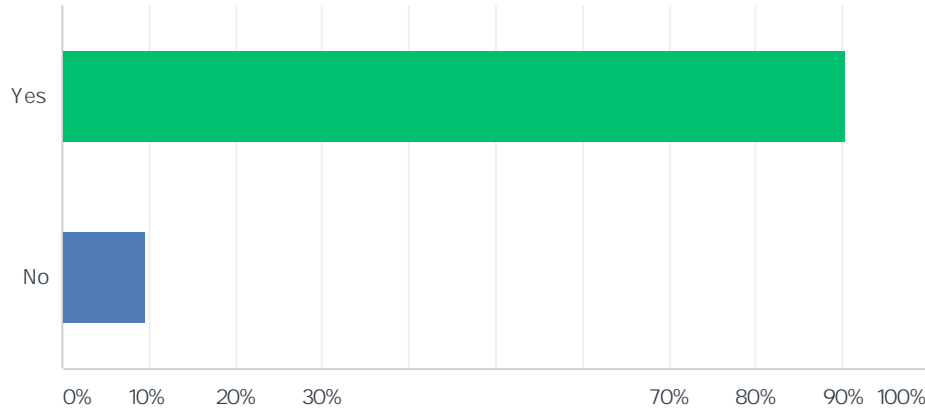


Q1 Are you a current YALSA member?

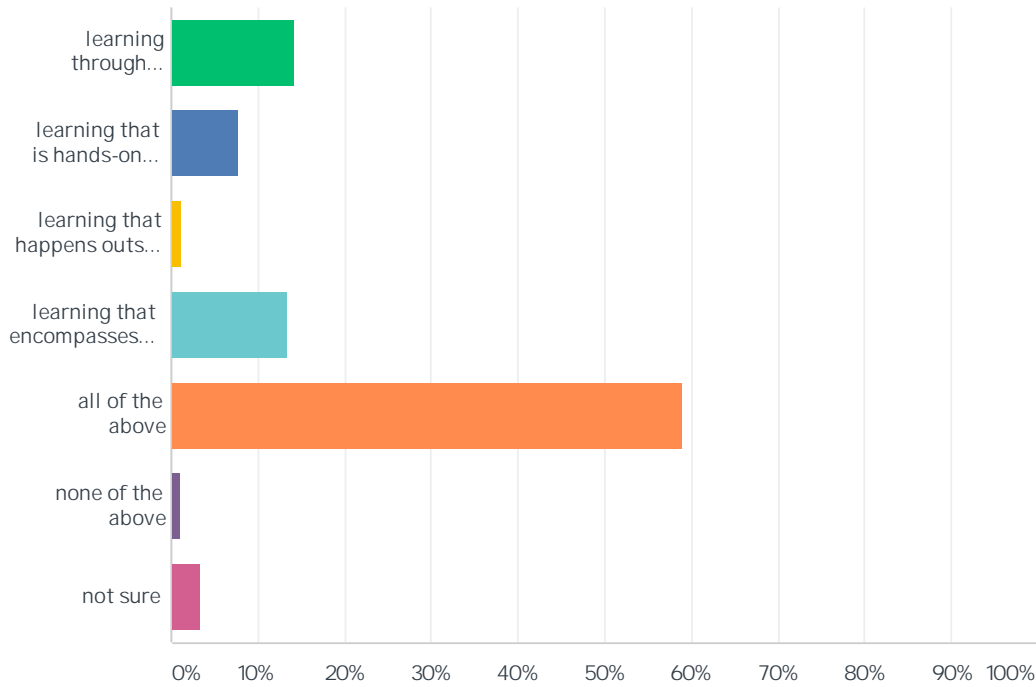

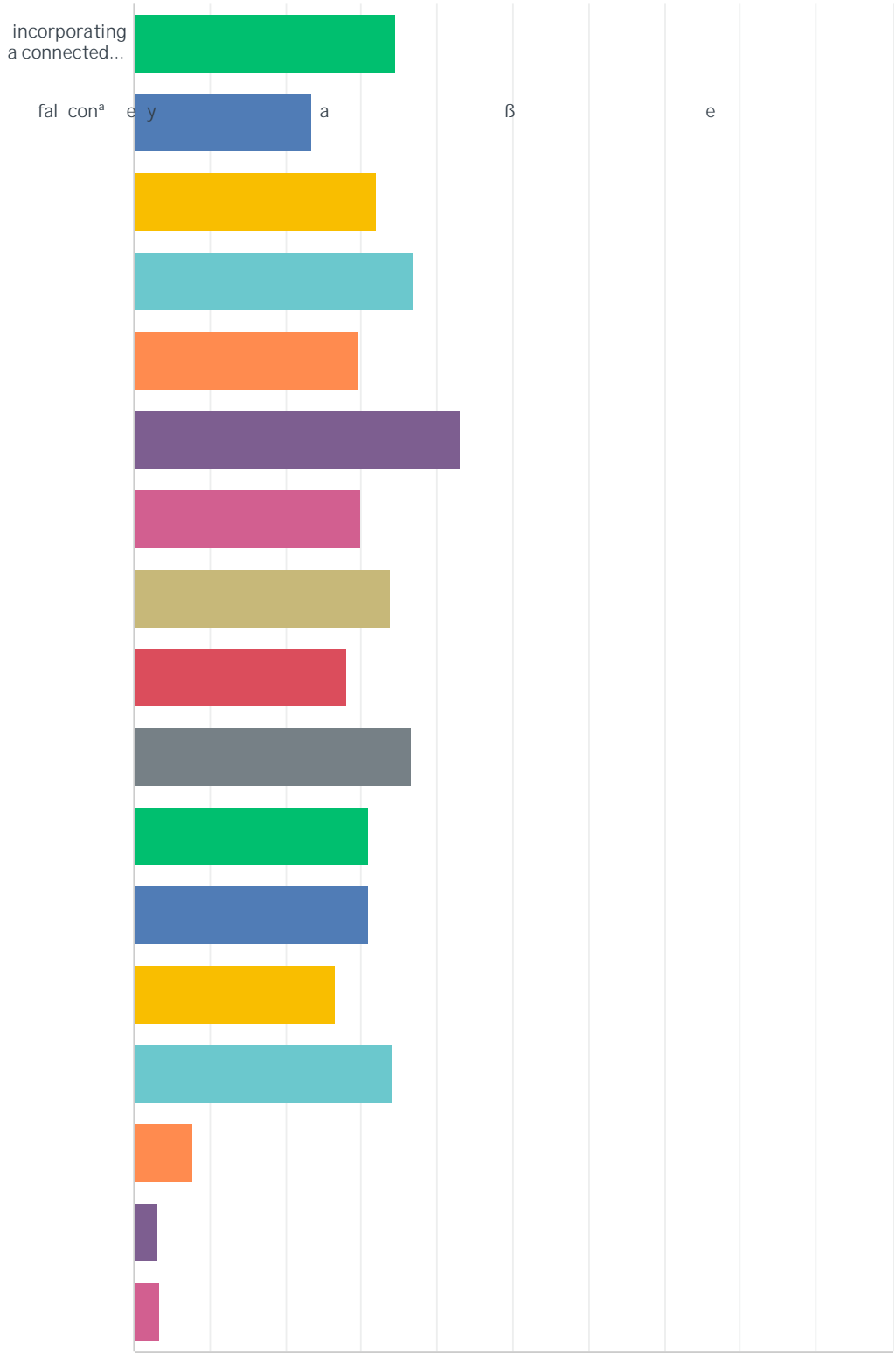

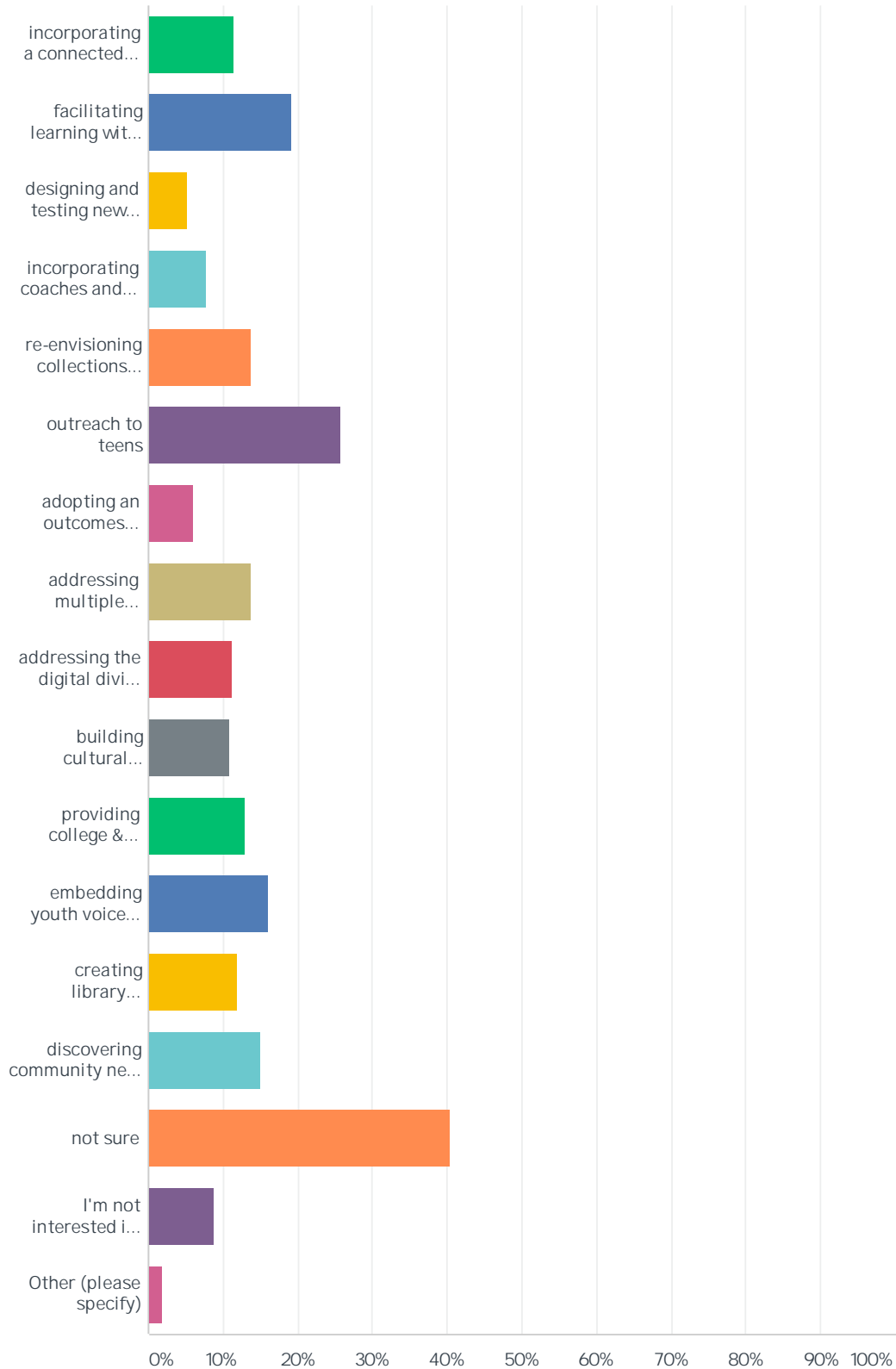

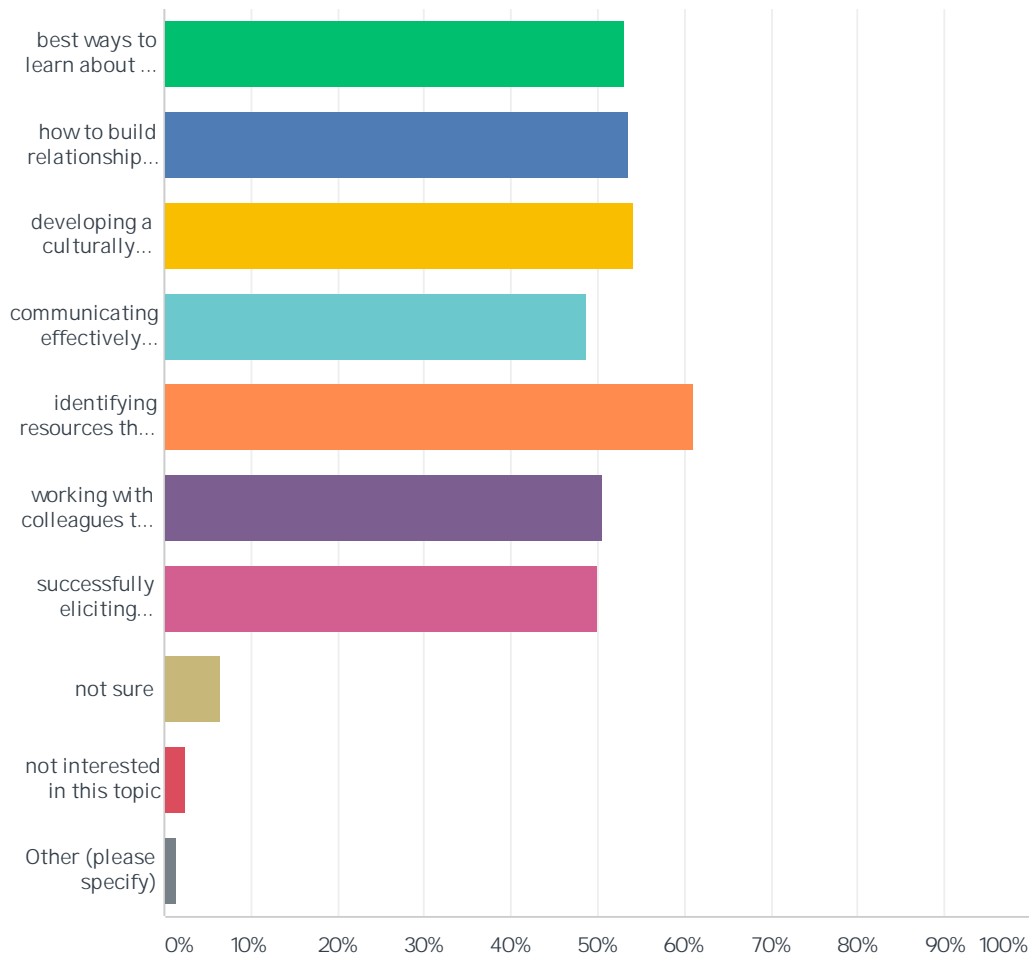

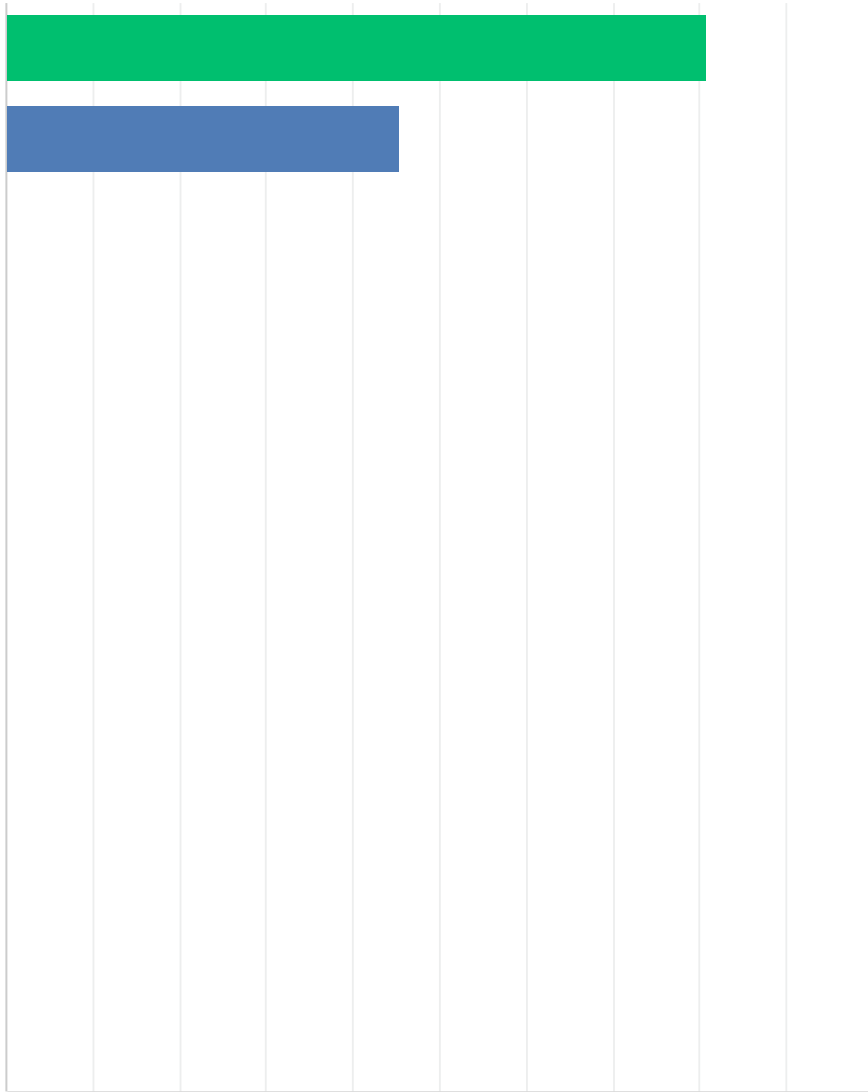

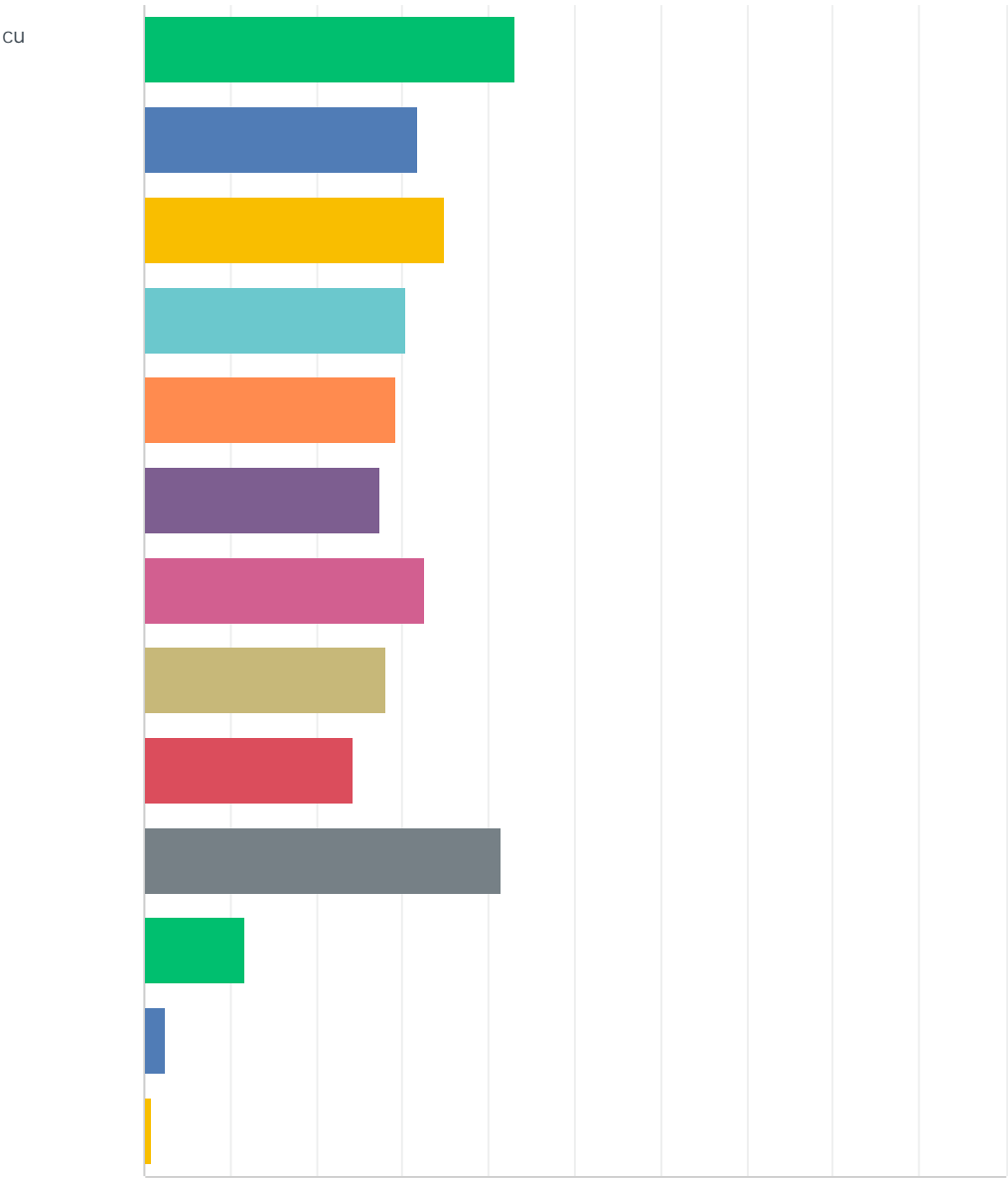

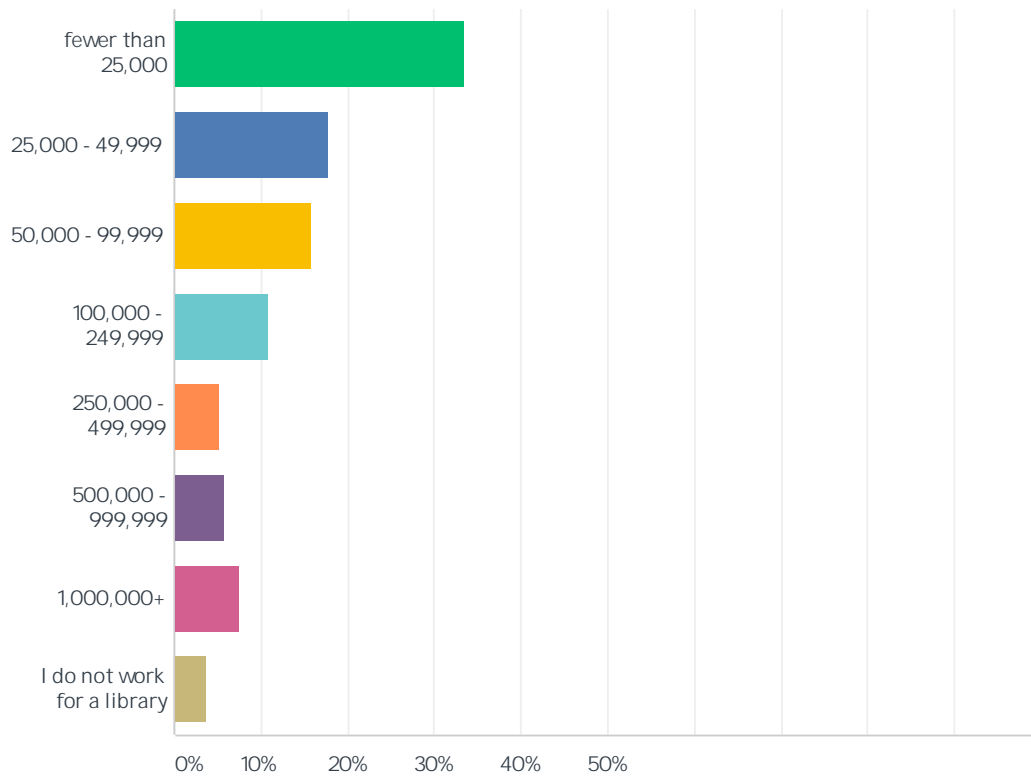
Q13 What is your preferred method of ONLINE learning? (choose one)

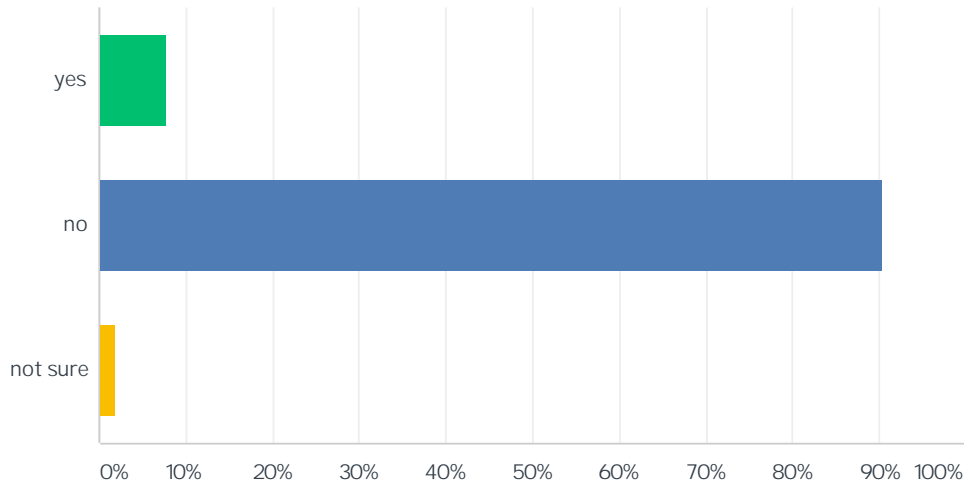
