

Q1 Are you a current YALSA member?





Q2 When you think about "connected learning" what comes to mind?








Q10 What areas related to cultural competency would you like to gain more knowledge and/or skills in? (select as many as apply)


Q11 What types of library advocacy activities have you engaged in within the past year? (select all that apply)

Q12 What areas of advocacy would you like to learn more about? (select all that apply)






