

**YALSA Board of Directors Meeting
ALA Annual Conference, Chicago
July 9-15, 2009**

Topic: 2010 Legislative Day on the Hill During Annual

Background: In 2010 the ALA Washington Office will not have its usual National Library Legislative Day in May. Instead it will be hosting a Library Advocacy Day on Monday June 28th in conjunction with the ALA Annual Conference, which is in Washington DC. The Board may want to decide if it is feasible to reorganize YALSA's conference schedule to so that members can participate in the Library Advocacy Day.

2. Modify the conference schedule to the extent possible to free up time for YALSA members to participate in Library Advocacy Day on June 28th.
3. Plan our own National Legislative Day for the second week of May 2010 and encourage members to participate in that.
4. Implement some combination of the above options.
