YALSA Board of Directors Meeting ALA Annual Conference, Washington DC June 24 – 29, 2010

Topic: Teen Space Guidelines Taskforce Establishment

Background: At the 2009 Annual Conference the Board accepted the report of a

taskforce that had been working on developing guidelines for teen spaces. The taskforce disbanded after the conference before the guidelines were finalized. In spring of 2010 the Board came to a consensus to establish a taskforce to finish work on the guidelines. Including the item as a part of this meeting simply ensures it will

be entered into the official record of the association.

Action Required: Consent

Proposal: Assemble a group of qualified member volunteers to review and refine the existing draft teen space guidelines.

Rationale:

- Guidelines can serve as an advocacy tool for members to use in their libraries, and advocacy is one of five goals in YALSA's strategic plan.
- Anecdotal evidence suggests that more public libraries are creating teen spaces; however, widely accepted standards for them don't exist at this time.

Proposed Action: The Board direct the President to establish a taskforce that will be responsible for refining the existing guidelines and submitting a final draft to the Board for review and adoption.
