Background:	The mission of the YALSA Blog is to provide a virtual space for publishing information about time sensitive issues and to provide a forum for members and the library community to discuss matters relating to serving teens through libraries. YALSA's Blog Manager, mk Eagle, has provided a report below.

Since Midwinter 2011:

-As of this writing, we've added 203 new posts since January 1<sup>st</sup>. These include regular YALSA Updates, posts from the Legislation Committee leading up to and following Library Legislation Day, and regular President's posts. We should also see the first in a series of interviews with newly elected Board members by the end of the month.

-As a result of a call for new bloggers earlier this month, we have added more than a dozen new bloggers.

-We formalized Matthew Moffet's role on the blog as our Podcast Manager. Matt has done a fantastic job in keeping our podcasts varied and timely, with a consistent rate of at least two podcasts per month published.

-We've added three new regular features: Tweets of the Week, App of the Week, and Point/Counterpoint. Linda Braun has spearheaded the first two features, and App of the Week now includes regularly scheduled posts from a rotating group of bloggers (including some brand new to the blog). The first Point/Counterpoint post was published this month, and we have two more installments already in the works.

-Blog manager mk Eagle will be participating in YALSA 101 at Annual. We also plan to continue live-blogging coverage of selected YALSA events, including the always popular teen feedback session for Best Fiction for Young Adults.
