**Objective 1d:** Graduate schools of library and information science develop and/or expand their teen and young adult services curriculum.

**Strategy:** Engage and partner with appropriate academic professional stakeholders and organizations within and without ALA.

**Objective 1e:** Increase YALSA's reach and impact.

**Strategy:** Establish and maintain strategic partnerships with targeted organizations whose mission and goals are similar to YALSA's.
